THE ACCOMMODATION







LIVING/DINING

We have extensively refurbished the house, with polished timber floors throughout, a modern kitchen and bathroom, a reverse-cycle heat pump, and a lounge with open fire, LCD TV and DVD.

BEDROOMS/BATHROOM

Bedroom 1 – One queen bed.

Bedroom 2 – One queen bed

and a single bed

Bedroom 3 – Two bunk beds

and a fold-out bed

The modern bathroom has a
toilet and walk-in shower, and
there is a separate toilet and

laundry.

OUTSIDE LIVING

French doors open to a large timber deck facing the ocean. Rinse beach sand off under the hot-and-cold deck shower, or relax with a glass of wine in our outdoor bath. Cook your freshly-caught fish on a wood- or gas-fired BBQ, and enjoy our brazier.



WHAT TO BRING

Bring all food, toiletries and beach towels. Spring Beach is 5 minutes' drive from Orford and its supermarket, pub, newsagency and post office, deli, café and restaurants. We recommend Scorchers by the River Gallery Cafe (for coffee and woodfired pizza), and the next-door Gateway Cafe. The supermarket is also very well stocked.

Spring Beach Holiday House is strictly non-smoking. We do not allow pets anywhere on the property.

WE PROVIDE

We provide, free of charge: basic foods (coffee, tea, pepper, salt, sugar...), firewood for the open fire (and a safety firescreen); pressurised water from rainwater tanks (we recommend that you boil all drinking water).

NOTE: We do not provide a cleaning service during your stay.

RATES

Please enquire about our rates at info@islandshacks.com. The base nightly rate is for two people, for two or more nights.

Additional charges apply for each extra person per night. There is no charge for infants in cots (cot provided) and babies.

Spring Beach Holiday House is also available for single nights, but conditions apply.




CHECK-IN

Check-out time is 10am; check-in time is 2pm. These times can be varied by prior arrangement.

DIRECTIONS

From Hobart, take the Tasman Highway (A3) over the Tasman Bridge, through Sorell, to Orford at the mouth of the Prosser River. Immediately before the bridge over the Prosser River, turn hard right past the supermarket onto the sealed main street (Charles Street, which becomes Rheban Road; C320). Continue south on Rheban Road for about 4km (5 minutes) to Spring Beach. Drive down the hill to the beach and continue south for about 200m to a small timber bridge. The Spring Beach Holiday House is the first house on the left up the hill after the bridge (about 200m). Number '371' is on the white fence.






